Minutes: Friends of Broadway Lake meeting

Date: 3/1/07

The March meeting of the Friends of Broadway Lake was held on Thursday, March 1, 2007 at 7pm at McFalls Landing.

Vice-Chair Mykael Ramsey, who was stepping in for Chairman John Steely, opened the meeting by welcoming all in attendance and introducing the board members present.

Copies of the minutes from the January board meeting were distributed to all in attendance. An update was given on the status of the Phone tree, and a sheet was started for needed corrections and additions. A handout was also available with local contact information for the county.

The Financial Report was unchanged from the prior month, with a balance of \$1,925.

Activity Reports:

- Roy announced that the Litter Blaster was set for March 3 at 9am. The "Log Out" is planned for March 31.
- Cheryl announced that Ken Kussmal will be at the boat landing on May 12 doing informal boating inspections. The Boaters safety course will be announced soon, tentatively, March/April.
- Refreshments for the meetings will be coordinated by Phyllis Gerhmann, and she had a sign up sheet available for anyone interested in assisting.
- The pot luck dinner is planned for November 1, and the golf course has agreed to let us use their facility again.
- Jody has planned our spring yard sale for April 14. He is working on a proposal for stocking the lake and also reducing the catch limits slightly.
- Mykael announced that Family Day is planned for June 9th with June 23rd as a rain date. The planning committee will meet March 8 at 7pm

Mykael introduced our guest for the evening, Sheriff David Crenshaw and Captain Roy Stuart. They discussed the crime in Anderson County and what has been done to eliminate it. They commended us on our community involvement and said that our type of group and good communication was the best deterrent. They discussed crime statistics for the county and had a question and answer session.

Other Announcements:

- Bill Strewing told us that the closing of the gates was being delayed to avoid damage to a piece of heavy equipment that was still on the lake bed. He was giving the owners until Sunday, March 4th to remove it.
- Leo Ortiz announced that a boater education course has been set up at Anderson Library and is free of charge. It will be held the second Saturdays of March, April and May.
